## Make sure your top talent develop their full potential with Fellowship of the CII

Fellowship (FCII) is the CII's highest qualification. It is acknowledged throughout the global insurance profession as an indicator of expertise and experience.

If members of staff hold the CII's Advanced Diploma in Insurance or are an Associate of the CII (ACII), then they have already shown their determination to carve out a successful career as an insurance professional.

The logical next step is for them to progress to Fellowship.

Fellowship is an exclusive qualification held by fewer than 6,000 working insurance practitioners. It is universally regarded as the premier qualification for the insurance industry, demonstrating an individual's knowledge and professionalism to colleagues, peers and other contacts.

Having staff members holding Fellowship inevitably reflects well on their employer, indicating the firm's belief in professional standards and sustained career development.

The Fellowship programme supports future professional development and reinforces the importance of ethical conduct. The programme is flexible, enabling it to be linked to work-based activity or, alternatively, it can be aligned to study for other relevant qualifications such as an MSc or MBA.

### What does it involve?

- **Completing the Business Ethics Programme (BEP).** This helps the individual develop the knowledge and skills required to make informed and correct decisions on any complex ethical issues that arise in their career.
- **Completion of a major achievement that develops and enhances insurance knowledge and skills.** This can include any of the following:
  - a 3–5,000 word dissertation
  - a further professional qualification
  - a report on a work-based project
  - a portfolio of published works.
- **Providing evidence of three years' Continuing Professional Development (CPD).** CPD lies at the heart of professionalism and is essential if an individual is to perform to the optimum standard, whatever their role.
- **Producing a Statement of Personal Achievement.** This is a 1000-word summary of the learning and development undertaken throughout the individual's progression to Fellowship, how this has changed their approach to their career, and how their career will be aided by what they have achieved.
